### **SEX TRAFFICKING IN THAILAND**



Sex trafficking in Thailand remains a significant issue, rooted in complex socioeconomic factors and cultural dynamics. The country is a source, transit, and destination for individuals trafficked for sexual exploitation, impacting thousands, including women and children. Thailand's tourism industry, which draws millions of visitors annually, creates Persons Act. enacted in a high demand for sexual services. This demand has led to the exploitation of vulnerable populations, often including impoverished

individuals from rural areas or neighboring countries like Myanmar, Laos, and Cambodia. Many are lured with false promises of legitimate employment, only to find themselves trapped in exploitative situations. Thailand has made strides in addressing sex trafficking, implementing laws and policies aimed at prevention and protection. The Anti-Trafficking in 2008, provides a legal framework for combating trafficking. However, enforcement challenges persist, with reports of corruption and a lack of resources hindering
